The Company provides its services and exercises its activities based on the Operational License 268/15 granted by CySEC. The Company is entitled to provide the services and exercise the activities only those and in regard only of those Financial Instruments that are stated in its operational license and/or any amendments or additions to it.

EDR Financial Ltd is a Company, which enables investors to independently trade on the Forex market using an Internet-based, electronic trading platform, which is provided by the Company. The Company works exclusively according to the respective, valid law and legal provisions of the Republic of Cyprus.

The Company will execute Clients' orders against own capital as an Execution Venue providing brokerage services in relation to one or more financial instruments.

1.1. Core Services

- Reception and transmission of orders in relation to one or more financial instruments;
- Execution of orders on behalf of clients;
- Portfolio Management;
- Dealing on Own Account;
- Investment Advice.

1.2. Ancillary Services

- Safekeeping and administration of financial instruments for the account of clients including custodianship and related services such as cash/collateral management;
- Granting credits or loans to an investor to allow him to carry out a transaction in one or more financial instruments, where the firm granting the credit or loan is involved in the transaction;
- Foreign exchange services where these are connected to the provision of investment services;

The above services may be provided and the activities may be exercised in regard of the following Financial Instruments:

1. Transferable securities.
2. Money-market instruments.

3. Units in collective investment undertakings.
4. Options, futures, swaps, forward rate agreements and any other derivative contracts relating to securities, currencies, interest rates or yields, or other derivatives instruments, financial indices or financial measures which may be settled physically or in cash.
5. Options, futures, swaps, forward rate agreements and any other derivative contracts relating to commodities that must be settled in cash or may be settled in cash at the option of one of the parties (otherwise than by reason of a default or other termination event).
6. Options, futures, swaps, and any other derivative contract relating to commodities that can be physically settled provided that they are traded on a regulated market or/and an MTF.
7. Options, futures, swaps, forwards and any other derivative contracts relating to commodities, that can be physically settled not otherwise mentioned in paragraph 6 of Part III and not being for commercial purposes, which have the characteristics of other derivative financial instruments, having regard to whether, inter alia, they are cleared and settled through recognised clearing houses or are subject to regular margin calls.
8. Derivative instruments for the transfer of credit risk.
9. Financial contracts for differences.
10. Options, futures, swaps, forward rate agreements and any other derivative contracts relating to climatic variables, freight rates, emission allowances or inflation rates or other official economic statistics that must be settled in cash or may be settled in cash at the option of one of the parties (otherwise than by reason of a default or other termination event), as well as any other derivative contract relating to assets, rights, obligations, indices and measures not otherwise mentioned in this Part, which have the characteristics of other derivative financial instruments, having regard to whether, inter alia, they are traded on a regulated market or an MTF, are cleared and settled through recognised clearing houses or are subject to regular margin calls.
